"The Mother of the Harvest" is a Primitive symbolic pattern, designed in honor of our Ancestors for celebrate the Harvest Time.

The corn is a symbol of the Harvest and Sun Gifts.

The Old woman at the center is the Ancestor and the symbol of all the Ancestors who watch over us and protect the Harvest.

They are honored at this time because they are those who teach us to gather the work of the past to live in our present and our future.

The Ancestor holds a Key: the past that she represents, as well as the seed from which the fruit is the Key to a good harvest.

In the other hand has a sprig of maize: the promise for future harvests.
